## Primary News

Kinder teachers are letting students get used to their new and more active routines. Kindergarteners are learning about alpha-friends and about how to be students in an elementary school. In math, they are learning about sorting and categorizing.

Meanwhile, in first grade science students have started learning how plants and animals survive in their habitats. They are working on predicting and asking and answering questions too. In math, students are learning the idea of graphing and understanding a graph.

In second grade, students are studying base ten in math and using manipulative. They are also practicing measuring with inches. In reading, they are working on fiction stories and increasing their fluency. In social studies, they are learning about maps and geography.

## News Around Us

Early in September, a fire was started by teenagers playing with fire works. The Oregon fires continued to rage for weeks. The fall weather has helped firefighters to contain the fire, but fire season isn't over yet. With all the rain, there are now flood and landslide warnings.

Hurricane Irma: This hurricane was the strongest Atlantic hurricane to hit the US since 2005. At its peak intensity, it was a category five hurricane. It had wind speeds of up to 185 mph. It's the second most intense Atlantic hurricane this season, second only to Hurricane Maria. It was about the size of Texas.

The earthquake that hit central Mexico on September 19, was a 7.1 on the Richter Scale and caused a lot of damage. Mexico City, had many collapsed buildings, cracked streets and gas leaks, due to the earthquake.



Favorite Sports




