## Terms & Conditions

1. Open to participants in Oregon and surrounding areas. No age limits apply. Participants may submit entries as individuals or a team (limited to 1 entry per person). Teams may consist of maximum 5 members with one member designated as the primary contact.
2. Entries must have a unique title and be original works that showcase an aspect of culture, heritage or tradition. Each entry must be a short film, with maximum duration of 15 minutes (including credits), be in English or with English subtitles. Submissions must be made through our website: [www.peaceart.com](http://www.peaceart.com). Each entry will be charged a processing fee of \$5.
3. The deadline for submission is 11:59pm on August 1st, 2024. As we do not have the capacity to store large movie files, your movie must be submitted via link. You may use Dropbox, Youtube with privacy settings preventing public viewing or store the movie in your Google Drive and share a link for judges to view the video. Entries received after the deadline will not be considered.
4. By submitting an entry, participants confirm that they are the rightful owners of the submitted content and have obtained all necessary permissions for any intellectual property or copyrighted materials used. Participants retain all rights to their submitted works however by participating, participants grant the organizers the right to use their film for public screening and promotional purposes.
5. Results will be published via this website approximately 30 days from the deadline, depending on the number of entries received.
6. Entries will be judged based on creativity, relevance to topic, storytelling, cinematography and overall impact. The decision of the judging panel will be final and binding.
7. Winners will be notified via email or other contact details provided at the time of submission. If a winner does not respond within 30 days, the prize may be forfeited and another winner may be selected at the discretion of the organizers.
8. Selected entries may be screened at public events or exhibitions organized by the competition organizers.
9. Entries that violate copyright laws, contain offensive or inappropriate content, or fail to meet the competition requirements may be disqualified at the discretion of the organizers.
10. The organizers will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury resulting from participation in the competition or acceptance of prizes.
11. The organizers reserve the right to amend these terms and conditions or cancel the competition at any time without prior notice.
12. Participation in the competition implies acceptance of these terms and conditions. By submitting an entry, participants agree to abide by these terms and conditions. For any inquiries or clarifications, please contact us through our website.
