What is Leadership?

Leadership is the student government program here at Brown. The primary purpose of the program is to develop confident and positive student leaders. Students also learn about teamwork, goal setting, decision making, and time management. In addition, students in the leadership program have a very important responsibility as they represent their peers in the student council meetings here at Brown. The Leadership class is also responsible for organizing and coordinating many activities. Some of these activities include: assemblies, spirit days, fundraisers, operating the student store, community service activities, dances, Parent Night, and Back to School Night.

How does Leadership work?

The Leadership program is an actual elective class that is taught during the school day by the Activities Directors. This class will fill one of your elective choices. Each student will take two electives each year (one elective per semester). For the individuals that are selected as Leadership Students, they will be assigned by the scheduling computer to either the first or second semester. Due to the limited number of spots in the class, you will no longer be allowed to waive a semester of PE for Leadership in addition to your full year elective. Student Council meetings are held during class time so you will only be required to participate in the meetings that occur during your assigned semester. The Leadership class is fun, but it also requires a great deal of responsibility, time, and energy.

How do I enroll in Leadership?

The Leadership program at R.A. Brown Middle School is a very important component to the daily life of Brown Middle School. The success of the Leadership program is due to the strength of the students that are selected for the program. As a Leadership student you must conduct yourself as a leader and be a positive role model at school.

Leadership selection is done by an application process. We will only review completed packets. It is therefore important for you to complete the checklist and make sure that you have turned in a complete application. Elections are **not** part of the application process.

A successful Leadership student is someone who is:

- responsible, organized, and willing to go the extra mile
- willing to attend and participate in many school related activities outside of the school day
- successful in the classroom and maintains at least a 2.75 GPA.
- a person of high moral character

Completion of this application packet **does not** necessarily mean that you will be selected for the Leadership class. The Activities Directors will evaluate this application and teacher recommendations. The Activities Directors will make the final decisions.

Please make sure that you use and review the Application Checklist. The application deadlines are very important.

What are the officer positions?

There are five officer positions within the Leadership class. They include: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Historian, etc. These positions can only be filled by eighth graders (next year's eighth graders) that were selected for the Leadership class. These commitments are full year positions in the Leadership class; officers are enrolled in the Leadership class for both semesters. These five positions are the **only** positions which students must "run" for. Elections, speeches, and an interview are all components of the officer selection process. **If you are interested in running for an officer position, please see Mr. Corwin prior to completing this packet. There is a separate application for officer candidates.**
